Purpose: To manage a sector of security related operations within the reserve

- Daily patrol coordination and planning to ensure the safety and integrity of designated section

- Skills development and administration of field rangers- management of field ranger team including supervision and skills development
- Assist the conservation department on incidents and respond when required
- Daily liaison with lodges and other security providers in the area of responsibility
- Any other security or wildlife protection related activities as may be required
